

Pupil Premium Impact of spending

2015/16

Children at National Standard at the end of Key Stage Two

- 31% of all pupils eligible for PPG achieved National Standard in Reading
- 54% of all pupils eligible for PPG achieved National Standard in Writing
- 31% of all pupils eligible for PPG achieved National Standard in Maths
- 46% of all pupils eligible for PPG achieved National Standard in Grammar

- 44% of all pupils eligible for PPG with no special educational needs achieved National Standard in Reading.
- 78% of all pupils eligible for PPG with no special educational needs achieved National Standard in Writing.
- 44% of all pupils eligible for PPG with no special educational needs achieved National Standard in Maths.
- 67% of all pupils eligible for PPG with no special educational needs achieved National Standard in Grammar Punctuation and Spelling.

1:1 tuition in writing had a 60% success rate in ensuring pupils accelerated progress and achieved National Standard.

1:1 tuition in Maths had a 50% success rate in ensuring pupils accelerated progress and achieved expected progress. Small group support also had 50% success rate.

Other measures of impact include:

- Language and Literacy Grammar and Spelling training saw improving outcomes for children eligible for PPG in Spelling Punctuation and Grammar assessments.
- Specific programmes to support children with emotional, behavioural and mental health issues have been successfully delivered and are impacting upon pupil's self-esteem and behaviours for learning.
- Educational visits funded for eligible pupils increased confidence and self-esteem.
