

Sports Funding Statement

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013-2014, 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school headteachers.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

The governors and staff agree that the money must be used so that all children benefit regardless of their sporting ability.

It is important this funding opportunity is used appropriately so that when it ends we have a legacy that can continue for future years. Our school places a high priority on our PE provision and as such, has invested in additional coaching and resources to further enhance the curriculum, PE and extra-curricular and competitive sports.

Sustainability Into the Future

The funding provided has allowed us to strategically build up staff expertise. Should the funding cease, we are confident we could sustain this provision on a long term basis.
