Sometimes waiting is quite ordinary, sometimes it is frightening or sad: waiting to be found out or told off or waiting to say goodbye to someone we love. Sometimes waiting is exciting, full of fun: waiting for a birthday, for good news, for the arrival of someone we like, for a holiday and for a treat. Every day there are times of waiting. We wait for ourselves to grow up, to move to a new school. We cannot remove waiting from our lives. Waiting is a mystery, there is a hidden meaning in all the times we have to wait. Everyone needs to learn how to wait well. Usually there is no option but to wait, but the important question is how we use the time whilst we are waiting. Good waiting involves hope and looking forward to what is to come. Some people might have a worrying wait for a longer period of time e.g. the return of a loved one in the army or navy or from an operation in hospital etc. For Christians it will be the prayer and support of their families or wider community that keeps them going.</p> <p>Task Draw a feelings thermometer like the one below and write alongside different scenarios for 'waiting'.
