If you have a Bible in your house, get it and have a look at it while you think about the following information:            The Bible is God's special book. It is all about how much God loves and cares for people. The Bible is the most important book that Christians use, because it is God's Word, so it is always treated with reverence. Like all special books we take care of it, make sure our hands are clean before we use it and keep it in a safe place.            There are two main sections in the Bible. The <b>Old Testament</b> tells us about the time before Jesus. The <b>New Testament</b> tells us about Jesus and the beginning of the Church. Some of the books are called by the name of the person thought to have written them: Mark, Jeremiah, Peter. Some are named after the person the story is about: Job, Ruth, Jonah. One is called after an event: Exodus. Others tell you about the content of the book: Genesis (Beginnings), Psalms, Proverbs, Letters. The Bible is like a library of different books just like we saw a variety of different books that we have at home and in school.  <b>Q</b> What is the Bible and why is it such an important book?  <b>Q</b> Why do you think we should show reverence for the Bible?  <b>Q</b> What does the first part of the Bible tell us?  <b>Q</b> What is the second part of the Bible about?  <b>Activity:</b>            Create a bookmark for a Bible including the title and pictures of your favourite story from the Bible.  <b>Handwriting practice</b>            Practice the letter S.</p>
