Come and See (R.E.)

Jesus died on Good Friday and he rose again on Easter Sunday. Jesus' friends were happy that Jesus was alive again, but Jesus told them he was going back to his Father in heaven. They felt sad about this, but Jesus told them he was going to send them a friend called, the Holy Spirit. Jesus said, "The Holy Spirit will lead you and guide you.
