



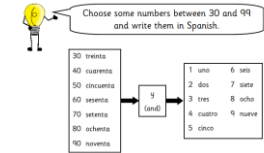

It helps you to be more descriptive.</b></p> <p><i>It is a tall, colossal dragon with leathery, impenetrable skin.</i></p> <p><b>A Description: detail sentence is a compound sentence in which two independent clauses are separated by a colon. The first clause describes and the second clause gives a detail to prove the first clause.</b></p> <p><i>The green dragon is greedy and selfish: it steals all kinds of treasure.</i></p> <p><b>A noun, w is an example of a sentence with an embedded/subordinate clause. The noun is followed by a comma then the embedded clause.</b></p> <p><i>Blue dragons, which are magical, are able to fly to great heights.</i></p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p><b>What are everyday materials made from?</b></p> <p>In this lesson, we will learn about natural and synthetic materials.
