English

Write a short article informing other children about what deforestation is. Use: Point, Evidence and Explanation.

For example;

Point: Deforestation destroys the habitats of many animals and plants.

Evidence: 10% of all animal species in the world live in the Amazon rainforest and at least 40,000 different plant species.

Explanation: These animals rely on the trees to maintain their carefully balanced ecosystems. Removing even a small selection of the trees could shift the balance enough to wipe out many species forever. **(If you miss the live lesson, look on the Teams assignment for instructions and ideas.)**

We will then find multiples of 2-digit numbers and use these to divide by partitioning into multiples in order to divide each part.
