A Description: detail sentence is a compound sentence in which two independent clauses are separated by a colon. The first clause describes and the second clause gives a detail to prove the first clause. The green dragon is greedy and selfish: it steals all kinds of treasure. A noun, w is an example of a sentence with an embedded/subordinate clause. The noun is followed by a comma then the embedded clause.
